Proposed Review of Zone GA CPZ

This document outlines proposals to review parking restriction times currently in operation in Zone GA controlled parking zone (CPZ). It is also an opportunity for you to tell the Council your views on how you think the CPZ is operating and on how the scheme could be improved. Please read the information in this document, then complete, and return the enclosed questionnaire - **postage is free**. Alternatively, this document is also available for completion online at <https://haveyoursay.brent.gov.uk>. Responses from within the consultation area only will be considered. The closing date for the return of the questionnaire is **24 August 2026**.

Why are we proposing this change?

The Zone GA Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) was originally introduced in 2005 and has subsequently been extended. The scheme boundaries and operational hours of 10am to 3pm, Monday to Friday, were established following public consultation undertaken at the time.

In recent years, the Council has received concerns from local residents regarding increased parking pressure on several roads outside the current CPZ operating hours. Residents have therefore requested that the existing operational hours be reviewed. In addition, the Council has received petitions from residents seeking a reassessment of the current CPZ hours to determine whether they continue to meet local parking needs.

What are the proposed improvements?

This review is focused on the current operational days and hours of the Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ). We would like to hear your views on whether the existing parking controls should remain as they are or be extended to cover longer daytime periods and/or evening hours.

The review also provides an opportunity for residents and businesses to suggest ways in which the scheme could be improved. This may include comments on the location and type of parking bays, parking enforcement, loading arrangements, or any other parking-related issues within the zone.

Please note that any changes to the operational hours of the CPZ would not affect the cost of parking permits.

What will happen next?

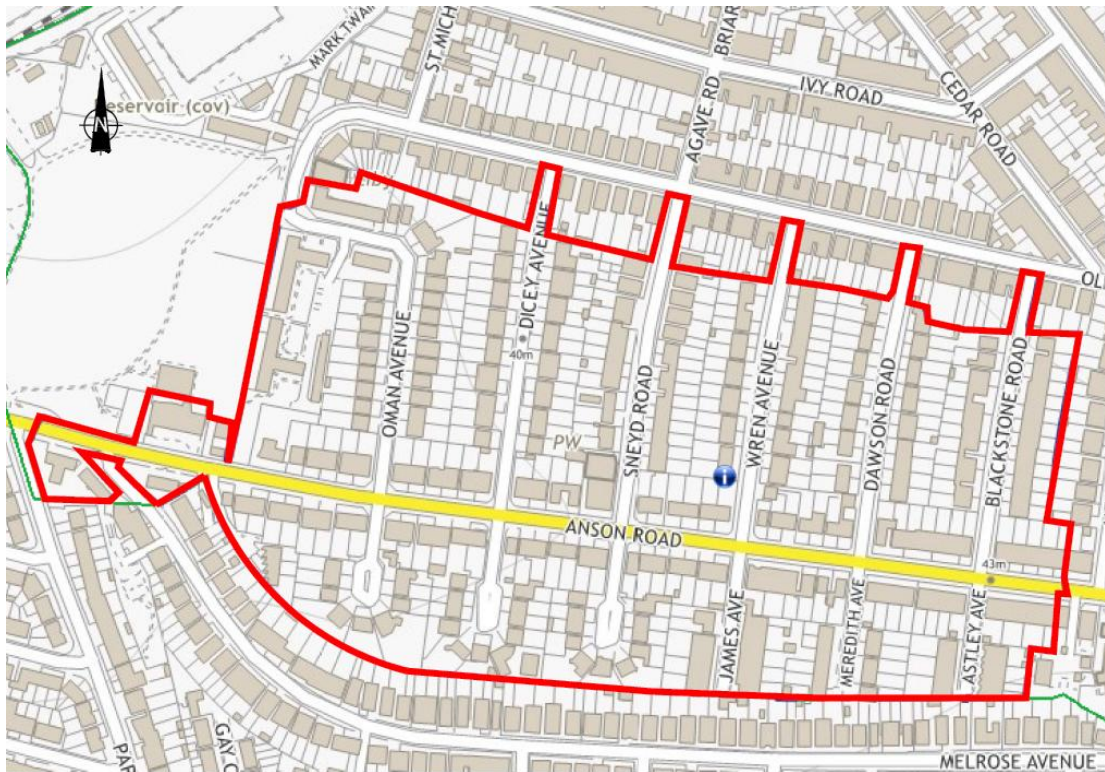
